As of 2020, Copernicus Masters and Galileo Masters are continuing to expand with the support of the European Commission (EC). 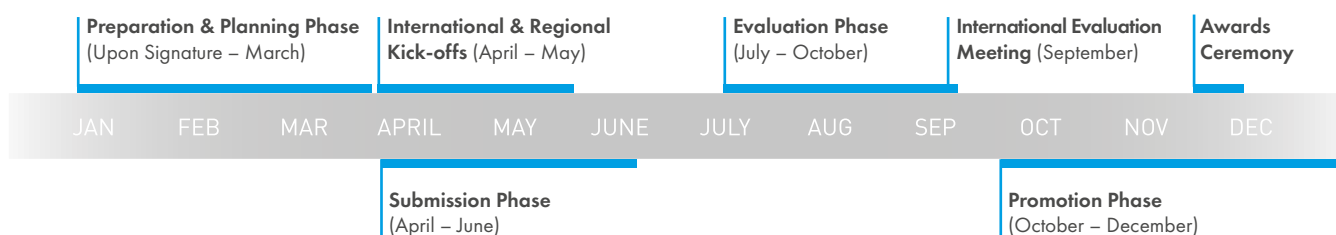
